Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** to the members of the State of Arizona Board of Examiners of Nursing Care Institution Administrators and Assisted Living Facility Managers ("Board") and to the general public that the Board will hold a regular monthly Board meeting, which is open to the public on: Monday, May 13, 2024, Regular Board Meeting, to be held at 1740 W. Adams Street, Board Meeting Room C, Phoenix, Arizona 85007 at 9:00AM.

The Board President reserves the right to change the order of the items listed on the Agenda except for matters scheduled at a specific time. Board members may be present by telephone.

During the course of the meeting, the Board, upon a majority vote of a quorum of the members, may hold an executive session for the purposes of obtaining legal advice from the Board's attorney on any matter listed on the Agenda pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3), and for the purpose of discussion or consideration of confidential material pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2). The executive session will be held immediately after the vote and will not be open to the public. As a reminder, the resident's name is confidential. You must refer to a resident by their initials or "resident."

Items that are referenced as a "Consent Agenda" may be considered as a single action unless a Board Member removes a specific item for review, discussion, and action separately from the other Consent Agenda items.

Board action on issues that are not listed on the Agenda is limited to directing staff to study the matter or to schedule the matter for further discussion at a future Board Meeting.
