## II. CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02(H), the Board can discuss or take action only on matters that are listed on the Agenda. Board action on issues that are not listed on the Agenda is limited to directing staff to study the matter or to schedule the matter for further discussion at a future Board Meeting.
